

CAMP FEES

This year NFNC and NCI are offering a sliding scale. The low end of the scale represents our basic cost (without overhead or labor) while the top end represents the price one might expect to pay for a typical event of this nature. Any money received above and beyond our basic cost will go towards a scholarship fund for lower income individuals and the improvement of this and future Summer Camps. We trust that you will pay as high on the scale as you are capable. Fee levels are adjusted to encourage early registration.
